Description

Students will be able to choose from a selection of projects, all of which will have various skill levels to suit individual learning needs. Students will be given advice on colour and the use of different beads. Several techniques will be covered with detailed notes on each project to take home to allow students to complete their projects if not quite complete at the time of finishing the course. But above all, a great course in an atmosphere of like minded people with lots of learning and lots of fun.

Size 11 Delica beads
14mm rivolis
Size 2, 3 & 4mm pearls
Size 3, 4mm bi cone crystals
Beading needles, thread and small, sharp scissors
A magnifier if you usually use one at home
