

Pique Assiette Mosaic (China and found Objects)

A creative course in which you will use found objects and china to mosaic a board, a pot, a frame - whatever your imagination comes up with! You will be guided through your own individual project to create a unique piece to take home. This is an opportunity to use all those bits and pieces you've been collecting over the years: the pieces of china you dug up, the buttons you didn't like to throw away, the shells and pebbles - whatever you can come up with!

Description

Using your found objects, you will learn how to choose the correct adhesives and grouts, how to cut mosaic pieces to make different patterns and designs, and apply your found objects.

You will learn the following skills:

How to design and plan your mosaic.

How to cut mosaic pieces.

How to apply mosaic.

How to grout and finish off your work.

Please bring with you

Some materials will be provided by the tutor. The approximate cost of these will be £5 to £30, payable to the tutor during the course.

Please bring with you any found objects and broken china that you might like to use. Also bring along anything you might like to apply mosaic to, e.g. planters, vases, mirror frames, et cetera. Be prepared to be flexible in using these! (Base boards will be available on the course.)
