As a fully qualified teacher, Jan plans an individual course for each lacemaker, discussing the options for each participant before the course starts. Jan teaches traditional bobbin laces:- Torchon, Bedfordshire & Bucks Point and is also keen to help those who want to push the boundaries in contemporary bobbin lace. Jan encourages all lacemakers to develop confidence and improve their skills in their chosen bobbin lace. She helps students to become independent learners confident in their own lace making skills, knowledge and competence. There is the opportunity to share specific learning, discuss possible solutions for tackling unknown or new lace techniques, within the group as well as individually.
