Embroidery on crochet can be beautiful, and this is a great class to try this fabulous technique. This workshop is inspired by Anna's latest book, 'Embroidered Crochet' by Anna Nikirowicz.

#### Description

During this workshop we will make a wall hanging. We will begin by crocheting a base, and then create beautiful mushrooms embroidery using well loved stitches. We will cover a great range of embroidery stitches, learn how to prepare our background and transfer the design. We will then complete the wall hanging by attaching it to the embroidery hoop.

3.5 mm hook

stitch marker

scissors
