Find your own creativity during this experimental course developing contemporary works on paper bringing together ideas to incorporate collage into pure watercolours and Ink. On this journey Jackie will encourage each individual to play with ideas, using luscious colours and a hint of original printmaking to compliment brushwork. Curious? Then come and see what happens when you gain the courage and confidence to let go.....!

Description

This course aims to encourage experimentation both with colour, papers, ink and more. We shall add texture that only the watercolour medium can achieve, as well as by other means!

By taking risks through the development of ideas can be so exciting, realising that the journey continues without end as we work together developing and discovering that the process can be addictive as well as fulfilling. The process of tearing work up is not destructive but forms a part of the creative process and that we just don't realise how much hidden creativity we each have hidden away!

Who can resist this permission to play'.....? Curious?.....

Please bring with you

If you already have watercolour equipment, bring what you have, whether it is in the form of 'pans' or tubes, but you may wish to add some other colours, brushes, and paper. I hope the following will assist in your choices:

I recommend the following, based on value for money and quality. I love Winsor & Newton professional watercolours, or Schminke in small 5ml tubes, and would suggest two reds, two blues and two yellows as follows: Scarlet red/Permanent Rose, Manganese Blue/Winsor Blue Green shade (Pthalo), Aureolin yellow/Indian yellow. This selection will give you a good range for mixing.

A large plastic palette as illustrated will be useful.

I have shown a selection of brushes which you may well already have, and so long as you have something that is not too small then that will suffice. I always have spare brushes like these for you to try during the course in any event. (For your information Brushes illustrated left to right are squirrel hair Mop, Swordliner, Small Flat, Large Flat, Large Wash otherwise known as a Filbert.) - I would stress this is not a shopping list and you may well have similar brushes already and are welcome to try mine.

As to paper, I would recommend Bockingford 300gsm NOT surface otherwise known as 'cold pressed', or you may well have a favourite. Minimum size A3 although buying in large A1 sheets is more economical. I would avoid so called 'practice paper' as this will not give very satisfactory results.

Low tack masking tape, or 'magic' tape.

Drawing boards and water jars are provided for your use, but please bring paper towels. If you require any other assistance, please do not hesitate to contact me.
